Welcome – The meeting was called to order at 7pm.

Treasurer's Report

Our current account balance, net of our expected refund for last year's Disney trip, is \$27,334.64. Income includes receipt of a check from the Pittsburgh Athletic Association for a strolling event. Expenditures included purchase of new tuxedos – needed because the incoming freshman class is atypically large, and more seniors are staying in the orchestra than usual. We also purchased a supply of checks because we will be using many more than usual as we distribute Disney trip refunds.

New business - None**Orchestra Director's Report – Sarah Lavelle, Orchestra Director**

The spring trip to Toronto is still awaiting School Board approval. Full details will be provided to the students as soon as approval is received. Many students are asking about an estimated cost, in order to determine whether or not to participate in fund raising activities. The estimated cost is now approximately \$700.

The trip is listed on the NA calendar. Students will probably depart early on the morning of Friday, March 31, and return on April 3, 2017. Departure will be from NASH, and will occur early in the morning to get out of the way of the usual school arrival. Some of the highlights will likely include: a dinner dance cruise at Niagara Falls, the Ontario Science Center, Casa Loma, and the Hockey Hall of Fame, in addition to the usual performance adjudication and workshops that are the focus of the trip.

The price of the trip will be all inclusive, covering accommodation, transportation, all meals and venue admissions. The hotel accommodations will allow either 4 or 5 students to a room. Approximately 20 chaperones will be needed for the trip, with the exact number dependent upon how many students participate. Chaperones will stay 2 per room, paying a subsidized rate, the same rate as the students. In order to be a chaperone, all clearance documents must be on file.

The students really enjoyed the Disney Concert that we did for kids last spring, so we will do this again.

The Chamber Orchestras will be playing at American String Teacher's Association in Pittsburgh. Performances will occur during the school day, and so will not affect pit performance in the spring musical. NASH Chamber will perform on March 2, while NAI Chamber will perform on March 3.
