

**North Allegheny Orchestra Parents Association Meeting
November 18, 2021**

The meeting was held in the orchestra room. In attendance were Directors Sarah Lavelle and Lauren Donato. Board members attending were President Julie Tarle, VP Melissa Kelly, Treasurer Les Hulver and Secretary Teresa Boley.

Sarah Lavelle discussed at length the upcoming playing tests, evaluation forms, and what the students will play for the concert and strolling.

Mrs. Lavelle talked about the Winter concert's schedule this year. She said in order to prevent having to limit the number of people in the auditorium, NAI orchestra will perform first then NASH orchestra. She said she will ask for attendance volunteers. The concert also will be live streamed.

Orchestra trip update – Mrs. Lavelle said there are 230 students signed up. She said there are two doctors going on the trip and she will follow up with chaperones. Twenty chaperones would be preferred for the trip.

Program ads – Jeanie Schott gave an update on the sale of program ads. There were \$4,285 in ad sales. The 32-page program will cost \$552, which is a profit of 85%.

Treasurer Les Hulver – The beginning balance as of Oct. 22, 2021, showed as \$56,329.61. The Giant Eagle gift card sales for November 2021 was a deposit of \$9,350 with a 5% profit to students of \$467.50. The spring 2022 first trip payment deposit totaled \$22,234.99. Expenses were \$8,882.50 for vendor gift cards, \$125 for small games of chance license. Ending balance as of November 18, 2021, is \$78,845.10. Copies of the November treasurer's report were available.

President Julie Tarle – Julie said Loafers finally got back to her about a restaurant night fundraiser and they are willing to do it. Moe's is also a possibility, she said.
